COURSE INFORMATION:

IQ Drive System **COST \$150**

(Required to service and install IQ Drive systems and zoning) Course covers the ins and outs of installation, service and repair of the IQ Drive system and zoning. Attendees will be given a book with all the component layouts, troubleshooting, and diagnostics to service this equipment. Credentials will also be given to each attendee to take the certification exam on their own time. (Approx. 6 hrs)

EPA Prep Course and 608 Exam **COST \$150**

Instructor led prep course and testing for Type I,II,III, and universal certification. (Approx. 6 hrs)

HVAC Fundamentals **COST \$120**

Course covers basic refrigeration circuit and how to troubleshoot using superheat and subcool. Also covers the basic components found in equipment and how to troubleshoot them including: compressor, reversing valve, TXV, contactor, gas valve, motors, common relays, and more. (Approx. 4 -6 hrs depending on class participation)

Airside Diagnostics **COST \$120**

This course will help with troubleshooting systems from the ductwork. We will look at common installation and design errors and how to correct them. Covers static pressure, wet bulb and dry bulb, duct sizing (ductulators), duct leakage and more. (Approx. 6 hrs)

NATE Review **COST \$130**
